Application

The compensating cable KN 41 L-SIL $2 \times 0.5 \text{ mm}^2$ is a silicone insulated cable which transmits the thermo-electric voltage of NiCr/Ni thermocouples. It is for flexible use and fixed installation in dry rooms with low mechanical load. They may only be installed outdoors with UV- and humidity protection and in observation of the max. permitted temperature range. The steel wire armouring serves as mechanical protection.
